What is Heraldry/Armory?

- Oxford dictionary definition:
 - Armorial bearings or other heraldic symbols.
 - These items are known as “armory”
- Arms vs Device
 - Coats of Arms represent an individual in period
 - Modernly now used as represent families
 - Family coats of arms are protected for families and shouldn't be registered
 - Device represents an individual or sca branch
- Do I need my AoA before I display armory?
 - No! It's called your device until you get your AoA then called your arms and you can display it!

Device vs Badge

- Personal Device
 - A single piece of tinctured armory which uniquely identifies that individual
 - Must have a tinctured background (field)
- Badge
 - A piece of tinctured armory other than a Personal Device
 - Can be for alternative personas, artist marks, households
 - Can be jointly owned
 - Can be fieldless (no required tinctured background)

Acceptable vs Registrable?

- Do you have to register armory?
 - No but we should make it acceptable
- Acceptable
 - Not offensive
 - Not Vulgar, not mocking any particular portion of the populace,
 - No hate symbols
 - Not presumptuous
 - No reserved charges (like orle of chains, crowns) when you don't have that award
- Registrable (in addition to the above)
 - design to be compatible with period style
 - Free of conflict with someone else's armory

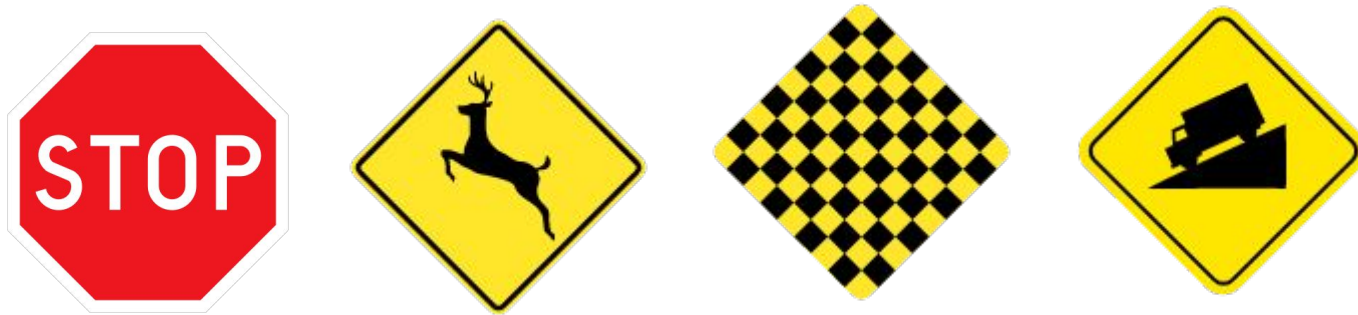

Basic Core Rules- Tinctures

- 5 Colours
 - Black (Sable)
 - Blue (Azure)
 - Green (Vert)
 - Purple (Purpure)
 - Red (Gules)
- 2 Metals
 - Gold/Yellow (Or)
 - Silver/White (Argent)
- Other ones available (proper and natural - ask a herald for help)

Basic Core Rules - Contrast

- Armory needs contrast
 - So we can see if from far away
- Traffic Signs have good contrast



Colour on a metal or a metal on a colour

Basic Core Rules- What we can put on?

- Lots of charges available (see [Heraldic Art](#) and [Pic Dic](#))
- [Ordinaries](#) are special charges
- Backgrounds can be change too ([Field Divisions](#))
- [Division Lines](#) can be change too

Basic Core Rules - Complexity

- Think of a sandwich
 - Layer 1: Bread (Background/Field)
 - Layer 2: Meat on the Bread (Charge)
 - Layer 3: Cheese on the Meat on the Bread (Charge on a charge)
- Keep It Simple
 - Rule of Eight = Heraldic Pizza!
 - All tinctures (colours, metals), items (charges, ordinaries) must count less than 9
 - At 9+ = OTHERWISE PIZZA!

Registration: What can I register?

How Many?

- What can I Register?
 - One personal device per person
 - But you don't have to have device
 - Badges
 - You can have all badges if you want!
- Total Registration Limit for Individuals?
 - Now 10
- Must have a registered name to file your armory
 - Can be your legal given name “of [Branch Name]” if you just want the device/badge registered

Registration: How to register?

How Long to find out?

- How register?
 - Work with a herald
 - Submissions/consult tables (like today)
 - Local herald (ask seneschal if you have one)
 - Join Avacal Heraldic Community FB group (we're online to help)
 - Once forms filled out, send to address on website with \$10/armory. Cheques or money orders in mail
- How Long to Find out?
 - About 9 months
 - 1-2 months at Avacal initial review, 3 months at society review, 2 months for decision and proofreading, 1 month for notification = $2+3+2+1=8$
