Greetings to the Avacal College of Heraldry from HL Rowyn Arden the Bard, Kingdom of Avacal Submissions Herald.

The following submissions will be forwarded to Laurel on the Avacal external letter dated 2016-04-30 and are taken from the Avacal KLoI of 2016-04-17.

1. **Jajiradai Batu** - New Name & New Device. *Argent, three pellets charged with a triskele argent, two and one.*

2. **Myrgan Wood, Barony of** - New Order Name and New Badge.

Blood of the Wood, Order of. The order name was initially submitted as “Blood of the Wood, Order of the”. Because this construction does not follow an acceptable order pattern, “Blood of the Wood, Order of “ (without the “the”) was provided to submitter during commentary. Because the submitter did not accept any changes, a new permission letter for “Blood of the Wood, Order of” has been received by the Submissions Herald

Argent, an elm tree eradicated proper leaved gules, a goutte d'Or on a chief vert.

3. **Myrgan Wood, Barony of** - New Order Name and New Badge

Elm Leaf of Myrgan Wood, Order of the

Argent, an elm tree eradicated proper leaved gules, on a chief vert, a leaf with stem to dexter argent.

4. **Myrgan Wood, Barony of** - New Order Name and New Badge

Gold Leaf of Myrgan Wood, Order of the

Originally, the order name was initially submitted as “Gilded Leaf of Myrgan Wood, Order of the “. The use of “Gilded” in Order names was disallowed (June 2014 Laurel meeting):

Precedent has been mixed regarding whether or not gilded can be used in order names. There is no evidence for its use in period order names, though gilded was used in period English sign names. Thus, we will register this item, but disallow gilded in order names after the June 2014 Laurel meeting. [Raven's Cove, Barony of. Order name Order of the Gilded Pheon, Dec. 2013 LoAR, A-Atlantia]

Although “Gilded” is grandfathered to Avacal, it is not grandfathered to the Barony of Myrgan Wood. “Gold Leaf of Myrgan Wood, Order of the” was provided to submitter during commentary. Because the submitter did not accept any changes, a new permission letter for “Gold Leaf of Myrgan Wood, Order of the” has been received by the Submissions Herald.

Argent, an elm tree eradicated proper leaved gules, on a chief vert, a leaf with stem to dexter Or.

5. Myrgan Wood, Barony of -New Order Name and New Badge

Silver Crocus of Myrgan Wood, Order of the

Argent, an elm tree eradicated proper leaved gules, on a chief vert, a crocus argent

6. Myrgan Wood, Barony of - New Order Name and New Badge,

Silver Hawk of Myrgan Wood, Order of the

Argent, an elm tree eradicated proper leaved gules, on a chief vert, a hawk volant rising argent.

The following submissions were Returned for further work.

1. Jajiradai Batu, New Badge.

(Fieldless) A pellet charged with a triskele argent.

As per the December Letter of Acceptance and Return (LoAR) 2013 (Jehan le Blanc):

“By long-standing precedent, we do not register fieldless badges that appear to be independent forms of armorial display. Charges such as roundels, cartouches, escutcheons, billets, hearts, lozenges, and so forth are all both standard heraldic charges and "shield shapes" for armorial display.”

Because of this, the charging of the black pellet (roundel) causes us to return it. Even if the submitter uses a black background with: *Sable, a triskele argent.*

It has a conflict with Kingdom of Trimaris: "Azure, a triskele argent" for the Order of the Triskele of Trimaris (LoAR June 1995).

The following submissions were Pended from Kingdom of Avacal.

1. Myrgan Wood, Barony of - New Badge (Populace Badge for Myrgan Wood)

(Fieldless) An elm tree eradicated proper leaved gules.

Conflicts with Walraven van Nijmegen "(Fieldless) A créquier gules". Currently, the submitter (Baronial Herald) is attempting to get a Permission to Conflict (PtC) letter.
