Greetings to the Avacal College of Heralds from HL Arwyn of Leicester, White Wyvern Herald, Kingdom of Avacal Submissions.

The following submissions will be forwarded to Laurel on the Avacal external letter dated 2017-12-31 and were taken from the Avacal KLoI of 2017-11-26.

Forwarded to Laurel Sovereign of Arms:

1: Dorothy Bolton -New Name & New Device, *Purple, in fess three owls contourny and on a chief argent a key purple.*

The blazon has been changed to *Purple, in fess three owls contourny and on a chief argent a key purple* to better describe the emblazon.

2: Kataryna Tkach -New Badge, *(Fieldless) A bear statant erect affronty forepaws elevated argent.*

The blazon has been changed to *(Fieldless) A bear statant erect affronty forepaws elevated argent*, to better describe the emblazon.

3: Kilian von Heidelberg -New Name.

4: Saxa Amelia Africa Na -New Name.

The following submissions were returned for further work:

1: Fionnghuala ingen Uilliam of Suthernelande - New Name

This name has some construction issues combining the elements. Fionnghuala ingean Uilliam is considered to be post 1200 and really cannot be combined with 'of Suthernelande'. A suggestion has been made for Fingula Wilelmi de Suthirlandia as possible suggest variant.

2: Fionnghuala ingen Uilliam of Suthernelande - New Device, *Purple, a lion sejant erect affronty and on a chief argent a bird striking affronty purple.*

Administratively, this device must be returned due to the lack of a name. Also, the proposed blazon would be *Purple, a lion sejant erect affronty and on a chief argent a bird striking affronty purple.*

"Striking affronty" is our best guess as to the proper blazon of the posture of the bird. This device would also be returned for use of a disallowed posture, striking affronty. An example of many returns from precedent, the return of Sarra the Gipsie's device from March 2000: The posture striking affronty is not allowed as it is not known in period armory and is inherently three-dimensional.

3: Fionnghuala ingen Uilliam of Suthernelande - New Badge, *Argent, three birds in annulo conjoined at the feet to a triskelion of spirals purple.*

Administratively, this badge must be returned due to the lack of a name. Use of two Steps from Period Practice (SFPP) of both the *triskelion of spirals and the three birds in annulo* invalidates SENA A2.B.4 where only one SFPP can be used..

The following submissions were pended until next meeting:

1: Saxa Amelia Africa Na -New Device.

This device was coloured with orange and not the standard heraldic yellow or Or. Therefore, we have pended the device in an attempt to get a hold of the client to approve the re-colouring.
